

Administrative Interview Process for Physician Assistants

The following process will be followed when setting up interviews for P.A.'s:

- All first time licensees or licensees that do not meet the criteria for the P.A. Supervision Affidavit must complete a face to face interview with a Board Member
- Supervision affidavit applies **only** to the following:
 - Physician assistant must have been licensed in South Carolina for 2 years or more
 - Supervising Physician must have previously served as a primary supervising physician for a physician assistant in South Carolina
 - Physician assistant must be changing to same specialty or a specialty they have previously practiced in
 - If **all** of the above criteria **are** met then **no interview** is required for the physician assistant or primary supervisor
- No telephone interviews unless deemed necessary by the individual Board Member
- Regardless to the method (face to face or affidavit) **ALL** scopes are reviewed & approved by the P.A. Committee prior to interview taking place or permanent license being issued
