

## **Residential Builders licensing requirement for reciprocity**

- 1. Completed application, properly signed and notarized.**
- 2. Waiver applicants do not have to complete the affidavit.**
- 3. \$15,000.00 surety bond that lists the individual as principal.**
- 4. Copy of current state license. If license reflects the company name, please provide proof that applicant passed the exam. \*\***
- 5. \$180.00 license fee (if the license is issued 12 months or less before the next renewal date) certified check, cashier's check, or money order only.**

**or**

- 6. \$260 license fee (if the license is issued for more than 12 months before the next renewal date) certified check, cashier's check, or money order only.**

**\*license expires June 30th biennially regardless of issuance date**

**Reciprocity waives the technical portion of the exam only, applicants are required to take and pass the Business and Law portion of the SC Residential Builders examination.**
